



## WEATHER UPDATE

For anyone renting a car, reserve a 4WD or AWD and you should be good for almost all conditions. If the highway patrol puts up chain requirements, the requirements apply to 2WD vehicles. Chains are not required for 4WD or AWD vehicles that have standard all-season mud and snow (M&S) rated tires or snow tires. Particularly around here, I can't think of a rental car company that doesn't put at least standard all-season tires on their rental fleet.

We spoke with the shuttle company last week. They advised that there were only two instances this entire winter where they cancelled shuttles because the road was closed for snow removal. Otherwise, their drivers are familiar with driving when it is snowing and the buses are equipped with snow tires and chains. If chains are required, there might be a delay, but they still make the trips.

Shuttle pick-ups and drop-offs have moved across the street from Bally's to Hard Rock Casino, but it is literally right across the street and a very short walk away. Below is the current language on [the shuttle website](#):

***\*IF THE ROADS ARE CLOSED THEN WE WILL CLOSE. IF THE DRIVING CONDITIONS ARE UNSAFE, WE WILL DELAY THE SHUTTLE UNTIL IT IS SAFE. OUR DRIVERS ARE EQUIPPED WITH SNOW TIRES AND CHAINS. IF THEY HAVE TO CHAIN, PLEASE EXPECT DELAYS.***
