Investigation: Dangerous And Persistent Chemicals Discovered At A Middle Tennessee Military Base WPLN


A family of man-made chemicals known as per-and polyfluoroalkyl substances, or PFAS, is starting to gain national attention after studies have linked it to health issues, possibly including cancer. It's prevalent at military installations around the country — including at Arnold Air Force Base in Middle Tennessee, where it's found at high levels in some water. And there are concerns that it could be spread.
