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Spray-coating for Motor Vehicles and Mobile Equipment Petition for Exemption

40 CFR Part 63.11169 - 63.11180, Subpart HHHHHH

Note: Facilities may now submit a NOTIFICATION instead of this petition. Whether or not you elect to do a notification, you are still required to retain records that describe the coatings that are spray applied. More importantly, you accept full responsibility for any mistakes, errors, or emissions you made since no regulatory agency is providing review.

Owners or operators of businesses that paint motor vehicles or mobile equipment may ask their state or local division of air quality and/or the US Environmental Protection Agency (US EPA) for an exemption from this rule if they can show that they **do not spray apply** any coatings that as sprayed contain any of the following Hazardous Air Pollutants (HAPs) above the applicable 0.1% or 1% threshold levels.

- cadmium (Cd)
- chromium (Cr)
- lead (Pb)
- manganese (Mn)
- nickel (Ni)

To apply for the exemption, you must provide the following information:

This form must be submitted in portable document format (PDF) via EPA's Compliance and Emissions Data Reporting Interface (CEDRI). CEDRI is accessed through the Central Data Exchange (CDX) at https:// *cdx.epa.gov.* Once fully registered, create a notification for Subpart HHHHHH and upload this PDF. If you are in a jurisdiction that has been delegated authority for 6H, also send a copy to that agency.
