  - Liability issues with using Google Translate for legal or technical info?
  - Need to use certified translators?
  - Best was to verify translation translate from English and then have someone else translate back to English.
  - Include disclaimer on all translations.
- Request for EJ case studies / examples related to small businesses (Tony). Nancy may have something. Jeremy – PA could also develop case study but would take time.

### Other discussion items

- o How to identify EJ communities in your state?
  - NH identified elementary school with highest use of school lunch program, high ratio of asthma.
  - IL EPA tool.
  - MN Promoted county grant programs for implementing new recycling requirements.
    Hard to find minority businesses interested because of distrust of government.
- Large businesses may be surrounded by smaller job shops, etc. that are small businesses (ex.
  Spirit manufacturing in KS). However, large manufacturers have largest impact.
- Communities / businesses may not want to be labeled as EJ. Don't need to frame it as EJ issue when talking to business.
- Do we consider small businesses in EJ communities as offenders or victims? Large businesses have greateset impact but small businesses contribute.
- NH autobody outreach in EJ areas how many not complying? Calcuated how much emissions could be removed if they all got into compliance. Had spreadsheet for calculating.

# Agenda repair – ADA compliance

# ❖ ADA Compliance (Americans with Disabilities Act)

- o Part of accessibility issue along with translations
- Microsoft Team creates transcripts automatically
- o Zoom also transcribes (see "transcribe" button in meeting), can do closed captioning
- o Automatic transcriptions not perfect, need to speak slowly and concisely
- Being ADA compliant may help states get federal funding

# Where to house info (agendas, minutes, resources)

- o How do subcommittees decide what to share on NSBEAP web pages?
  - Post most current minutes, recordings, etc., only most timely info
  - Archive older materials
- Create internal place to store info, then decide what to post publically
- Planning Committee uses dropbox
  - SharePoint Renee has set up SharePoint with externals, works fine
  - Teams channel might not work across agencies
- NSBEAP page
  - Could be dropdown under Small Business (similar to sustainability page)
  - Share best resources, case studies, etc. to help all SBEAPs address EJ

### Translations

- o Google Translate live on NSBEAP site and ADA compliant
  - Only translates text, not docs, text included in graphics, hover over pop up text
  - Look into analytics to see how many using translations (great metric to report on for grant) –
    Nancy will look at analytics after a month.
  - Send Nancy info on any issues we see. Nancy will share with IT.
  - YouTube tracks video views.
- Good topic for Annual Training
- Create resources for accessibility: ADA tips, addressing letters without Ms./Mrs., translation tools
- o Ask our agencies about translations, ADA, etc. Might be using tools we don't know about.

# Annual Report – What question(s) to ask?

- Specific options?
  - Quantifiable preferred.
  - How many small businesses we work with are in EJ areas? Would take too much work to determine.
  - Programs use different tools/quantify in different ways so hard to get accurate data.
  - Could be misleading if just yes/no.
- Open ended?
  - Tell a story / case study.
  - Don't always get good reponse rate on open ended questions on annual report.
- What will we do with results?
  - EPA leadership interested in what we're doing on EJ.

# ❖ Title VI disability info

- Funding is available.
- o EJ focuses more on minority populations and income.
- Need to address accessibility.
- o Sara's agency has lost funding because they weren't addressing Title VI.

### Mission statement / NSBEAP web page

- Brainstorming mission language in Google Drive doc.
- Guidance from Tony on how to write mission statement.
  - 1-3 sentences.
  - Never exceed 100 words.
- Start with simple mission statement to focus what we're working on.
- Can always evolve later.
- SBA example:
  - Collectively provide SBA with input, advice, and recommendations on strategies to improve and strengthen equity among women, veterans, minority-owned businesses and/or businesses from low-to-moderate income or rural communities.
  - Rural communities: Could include bandwidth / internet connectivity in rural communities, especially important during COVID when libraries and schools were closed. Issue with electronic reporting for 6H, etc.
- EJ web page content:
  - Mission statement
  - Definition of EJ
  - Reference to executive order
  - Justice 40 info
- Working draft mission statement:

Explore how SBEAPs can address environmental justice (EJ) concerns in their states through small business assistance, share ideas and experiences, and make resources more accessible to all audiences.
